Have you noticed the new bins?

We have been assessed and helped by LiteClub, a free organization that looks to improve a club's environmental footprint. They will send us a report soon, but we did do well due to the recent upgrading work. There are a few things to work on and we will. Here are 3 ways we can improve;

1. Water Usage:

- Toilet flush: hold the flush button down only until the job is done, water stops when you let go

2. Electricity:

- Close all doors and windows where the heat pumps are working
- Turn the lights off when you are leaving a room empty of people

3. Rubbish & Recycling:

- Rubbish & Recycling works best if everyone takes responsibility for the things they generate, so please help us all by doing your bit.
- Please make yourself familiar with the new bins for rubbish types and use them appropriately

Note: Bottles still go in the old recycling bin behind the large server island.

Re our heat pumps: We spend about \$450 per month in Summer and \$850 per month in Winter for electricity. I know that we can do better and be more comfortable. Here is how;

- Close the doors and windows in the area you are using, so that the heat pumps need to work less, this will also reduce the draft.
- The centre of the room is where there is most draft, and so coldest in Summer when cooling is done
- Sit according to your preference of heat and draft

Locking up at the end of the evening: On a number of occasions recently the rooms have been left unlocked and/or not alarmed. Please ensure this does not happen again, as it may void our insurance and it costs us \$69.00 for the security firm for the call out.
