Training opportunities:

Advanced Improver Lessons:

This year, we run *NZ Bridge Intermediate Lessons*, aimed mainly at Senior, Senior Reserve and experienced Intermediate players. We alternate lessons Friday night and Sunday afternoon, when the club rooms are available. The cost is \$5 per lesson, and lessons will start at 7.00pm on a Friday and 2.00pm on a Sunday. They will run for two hours; one hour of lesson and one hour of play.

Sunday 18 August – NZB Lesson 6 – Competitive Bidding, when we open the bidding

Friday 23 August – NZB Lesson 7 – Competitive bidding, when we overcall

Sunday 22 September – NZB Lesson 9 – High Level Bidding

Friday 11 October – NZB Lesson 10 – Defence against opponent's Pre-emptive Opening Bids Sunday 20 October – NZB Lesson 13 – Splinters and Roman Key Card Blackwood.

OTHER NEWS

Christchurch Mid-Winter Teams Tournament:

The Christchurch Bridge Club hosted their Mid-Winter Teams tournament on 27 July and two of our senior players achieved very good results. Phillipa Borlase was in the top Inter Team and Peter van Leeuwen was in the second team.

About the Crockfords survey:

The overall survey response rate is 42 percent, or 109 out of 260 members. We are very grateful for the feedback we have received, and overall, we see it as a satisfactory response level. The results are summarised as follows.

- About one third of our members will usually play two or more sessions per week.
- Almost one quarter of total responses belonged to another club, and they were likely to play at the other club in one session per week.
- About half of respondents offered their expertise and experience in support of club tasks and duties.
- There is some interest, slightly above one third of responses, in attending a daytime session (open/mixed grade) on any weekday. We have one scheduled open/mixed grade session (Thursday afternoon). There is an opportunity to investigate the option among interested members and the wider Bridge playing community.
- Nearly three-quarters of members use their own car for transport. However, there is significant interest shown in support of carpooling.
- There are many members using multiple communication channels. Newsletters and email communications are the most preferred.
- A fortnightly newsletter is the clear preference, with no reason to change the frequency.
- There is a high level of satisfaction with the current content of the newsletter. While that does not
 preclude adding additional information into it (such as more photos and sponsor profiles) the core
 components are correct for the audience.
- A majority of members are visiting the website after they play, which for most members is once a week and for some twice a week.
- A clear majority of members are visiting the website primarily for results.
- While most people surveyed did not support creating a members' portal, if the 'don't know' and 'maybe' are added to the 'yes' responses it's an even split.
- There is little support for using social media to communicate with members.

The Committee is progressing work on a review and update of our website, with the support of a website developer. While the current website content will remain unchanged, we are keen to include updates to photographic presentations of our facility and to include portraits of our contacts.
